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Dear Madam, dear Sir,

due to an amendment of the Biofuel Sustainability Ordinance (Biokraft-NachV) and of the Bioelectricity Sustainability Ordinance (BioSt-NachV), the following changes shall enter into force by 10.07.2018:

1. Introduction of a specific category „Residues from Agriculture“
2. Further details regarding biofuel on the proof's 'Details' page
3. Updated Biomass Code List

ad 1. Introduction of a specific category „Residues from Agriculture“

As residues from agriculture must meet the area-related sustainability criteria pursuant to §§ 4-7 of the sustainability ordinances, a specific category „Residues from Agriculture“ is introduced.
The related biomass codes are listed at the end of this letter.

Last interfaces are affected as follows:

Due to the introduction of the category „Residues from Agriculture“ the mask that collects information on sustainability requires an additional declaration („The bioliquid or liquid/gaseous biofuel has been produced by residues; the residues do stem from agriculture, forestry or fishery nor from aquaculture.“) This declaration must be used for the biomass codes concerned. Your declaration will appear on the proof accordingly.

Consequently, along with the change concerning the entry of information, the csv-format will also be changed. The new format, with relevant changes being highlighted, is provided in the **Enclosure**.

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Current proofs are affected as follows:

The BLE automatically transfers to the new category such proofs which already include the biomass codes concerned. You do not need to do anything.

The following rule applies to the small number of current proofs which consist of mixtures and now belong in two categories: The BLE shall block these proofs and they can be reactivated upon an informal request submitted by their owner to nabisy@ble.de. Such reactivated proofs, however, may then only be transferred or divided; they can no longer be combined.

The following applies to suppliers after of the last interface:

The restriction which prohibits the combination of proofs for cultivated biomass with proofs for waste and residues also applies to proofs for the new category.

Consequently, proofs of the same category may continue to be combined, while the combination of proofs of different categories is prohibited.

The overview below illustrates the types of acceptable combinations with respect to the categories:

	Cultivated Biomass	Waste and Residues	Residues from Agriculture
Cultivated Biomass	✓	✗	✗
Waste and Residues	✗	✓	✗
Residues from Agriculture	✗	✗	✓

ad 2. Further information about the biofuel on the proof's 'Details'-page

On the 'Details' page which is printed out with every download of proofs, further details relating to the proof are published:

- indication of the abbreviation according to the list of biomass codes,
- indication as to whether or not the biomass code designates either advanced biofuel within the meaning of § 2(6) of the 38th Regulation on Emission Control (BimSchV) or conventional biofuel within the meaning of § 2(4) of the 38th BimSchV, or neither.



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ad 3. New Biomass Code List

By 15.08.2018 at the latest, the BLE will publish an updated version of the Biomass Code List on its website www.ble.de/biomasse, where you will find the most recent version of the list.
